I went to the Coach Inn, Banbridge on Saturday night 26th April 1997, I went along with Victoria Clayton from Portadown. We went in the bus from Portadown. We got the Portadown bus home again, it left Banbridge at approximately 1 15 am. I was with Victoria Clayton on the bus home. I can remember seeing Kyle Magee and Pauline Newell on the bus on the way home. I was sitting near the front of the bus. The bus arrived at Portadown at approximately 1 40 am and stopped at Herrons Country Fried Chicken at the bottom of the town. I got off the bus with Victoria, and Kyle Magee joined us. We walked up the street to Boss Hoggs. The three of us went into Boss Hoggs and I stood inside the door talking to Kyle. Victoria got something to eat for us. The three of us left together and walked up the town centre. We walked up the left hand side of the street to the traffic lights in the centre of the town and then we crossed over and walked on up the town past Jeffers. There were a few people in the centre of the town, but I don't know them and I didn't pay any attention to them. I recall seeing a police landrover parked somewhere on the main street, I can't remember where. The three of us walked on towards St Mark's Church at the top of the town and while walking past Connors Chemist I
