My name is [REDACTED] I am the mother of Tracey Clarke, [REDACTED]  
[REDACTED] During 1997 Tracey lived with me at [REDACTED]  
[REDACTED]. Also in 1997 my brother Michael McKee and his wife Andrea  
lived across the square at [REDACTED]. I can recall  
during 1997 a particular incident occurred in Portadown when Robert  
Hamill was beaten up. I remember the Sunday after this Tracey had  
been to the Coach that Saturday night and on the Sunday morning I had  
the news on, on the radio. It was around 12 midday when the news was  
on and I remember Tracey turning the radio up at the news. She told  
me that she had seen an awful fight in town last night. Her father  
Jim Murray was also present. When Tracey talked about the town she  
meant Portadown and always referred to Portadown as the town. She  
said the ambulance was there and she thought the fellow was dead  
because they had a blanket over his head. She didn't mention the  
names of anyone involved in the fight. Alistair Hanvey a boy from [REDACTED]  
[REDACTED] had been going out with Tracey however I know on that  
Saturday night Tracey didn't go to the Coach with him but I think they
