SIGNATURE OF WITNESS

I am the husband of [REDACTED] who is commonly known as [REDACTED] Clarke. I live at [REDACTED]. My wife's brother Michael McKee lived at [REDACTED] with his wife Andrea which is just across the square from us. In 1997 I was living at this address with my wife [REDACTED] Tracey Clarke and my son [REDACTED]. I can recall the 27th April 1997 as I remember hearing about an incident on the radio that morning. Tracey told me prior to the radio news about the big fight. Tracey said she stayed to watch because it was great crack. I remember her sitting on the chair at the kitchen with her back to the back door, that was always her seat. She said they all came back from the Coach and there was a fight. She said a lot ran up to the fight and Alistair Hanvey was there. I don't know if Alistair went to the Coach but Tracey saw him in Portadown. Tracey and Alistair's relationship was on one day and off the next. I remember the news coming on sometime that day but I can't be sure if Tracey was there when it came on. I remember sometime on that day and Tracey saying she didn't want to go out with Alistair anymore because of what he'd done. I think this was because of the injuries Hamill had. Tracey was saying that Alistair was an animal if he'd done that to Hamill. I remember
