

I spoke today by telephoned with D/I Irwin at 4pm  
He informed me that since Drumcree 97 the  
attitude of protestants towards RC's had hardened and  
it could not be guaranteed that witnesses A + B  
would now be willing to give evidence.

He stated that Prunty could only be contacted  
via Rosemary Nelson Solicitor and that to date she  
has not answered police correspondence on this case.

He stated that he was going on leave next  
week and would be in court on 20, 21 + 22 October.  
He stated in the meantime he would write to  
[REDACTED] and try to set up consultations with  
witnesses A, B, Prunty and Wright for 23 and  
24 October. He is to contact me to arrange  
the consultations.
