I refer to your last letter of the 24th August 1998. I confirm I have had a lengthy meeting with Detective Sergeant Bradley. When the above case was then in the List for mention on Friday 11th September 1998 I spoke to Detective Sergeant Bradley and Detective Inspector Irwin. I was advised by them that with regard to documents, notes etc relating to 27th April 1997 and referred to in paragraph 3 of my letter of the 12th August 1998 apparently there are none in existence.

However, I have yet to receive the witness statements referred to in paragraph 2 of my letter of the 12th August 1998. In addition I would have thought there were documents with reference to paragraph 4 and 5 of the same letter. Detective Sergeant Bradley clearly understands the matters which are now being sought and perhaps you can make sure that any documents which should be disclosed are disclosed now that a Trial date has been fixed.

In addition the Police Officers advise me that all maps, photographs, video etc were with your own Department. Obviously I would like copies for myself and Senior and Junior Counsel very quickly. With the new Crown Court arrangements I will obviously be less available to collect things from your own Department and therefore would rely on Police delivering them to my office in Portadown or else normal post.
