

- 7.2 At present the service is not as well equipped as it should be to deal with the most serious and complex murder investigations, typically involving terrorist or organised crime activity. Recommendations are made as to how that position might be improved.
- 7.3 The extent of work, commitment and resources required to make the recommendations come alive is not under-estimated and the Chief Constable will obviously need to consider a staged, project managed course of action, drawing where appropriate on the expertise and experience of officers from other United Kingdom forces.
