6	08/12/00	<p>DCI K informed me that an intelligence source indicated that Michael McKee might be seeking employment in Southern Ireland. This followed a domestic dispute with his current partner. I agreed with DCI K that in view of extradition difficulties, then Michael McKee should be arrested for his part in the above conspiracy, if he attempted to travel to Southern Ireland. I was also informed that DCI K had recently taken a statement from a Constable G who at the time of the murder was part of an RUC close protection team guarding Robert Jameson. During the interview Constable G declared that he had provided information to DI Michael Irwin, which implicated Timothy Jameson (son of RJ) in the murder of Robert Hamill. DCI K was concerned that subsequent enquiries made, following his conversation with Constable G indicated that the information passed to DI Michael Irwin might not have been dealt with correctly. It was agreed that we would discuss this further upon my return to Belfast on 11/12/00.</p>
