in, as follows:

I believe:-
the offence has been committed, namely, *murder*
of substantial value (whether by itself or together with other material) to the investigation
is on premises of *Altitude Harveys*
to be relevant evidence and,
that it does not consist of or include items subject to legal privilege, excluded material or special procedure material.
Where the provisions of section 10(3) of the Order applies, namely,
that it is not possible to communicate with any person entitled to grant entry to the premises;
that it is not possible to communicate with a person entitled to grant entry to the premises but it is not possible to communicate with any person entitled to grant access to the evidence;
that the premises will not be granted unless a warrant is produced;
that a search may be frustrated or seriously prejudiced unless a constable arriving at the premises is granted entry to them,
