

12. I have been told that Beverly Irwin and Stephen Thornbury have stated that they were outside for a period of time. They may well have been outside, but I can not recollect at what stage.
13. On page 7792 it says I *“went to toilet window other staff already there, looked down Thomas Street, observed 2 fellows down on ground”* I can remember that those two individuals were on the ground when I first saw them. Looking at the photograph [page 224], I can say that they were both on the mouth Thomas Street and Market Street. One was on one side of the road and one was on the other side of the road although I am not now sure exactly where they were.
14. I am not sure whether I saw the 2 men on the ground for the first time through the window or when I was outside the door. I do remember that a girl went to one of the men. Looking at the photograph at page 224 I can say that I believe she went to the man on the same side of the road as Jameson’s and cradled his head on her lap. She was calling for an ambulance. The other man was on his own.
15. At page 7792 it is noted that I said, *“fellow wearing black jacket lying level with Thomas Street, 3 - 4 feet into middle of road.”* I couldn’t honestly say now which of the 2 men on the ground was wearing a black jacket.
16. When I was at the front door, I saw that there was a police presence in the area of the junction. I have been shown a photograph [page 226]. Looking at this photograph I can say that they were in the general area of the junction by the Alliance and Leicester. From the door I had a restricted view of that area because of the buildings; this is confirmed by looking at the photograph.
17. I have been shown a photograph [page 225]. Looking at this photograph I can say that I saw the police officers in the middle of the road. I could not tell you how many I saw but it was more than one.
18. I stepped outside the front door of the bar furthest from the Market Street junction (the other door was shuttered). I am certain that there were police at the
