**STATEMENT OF JULIE SHERWOOD**

I, JULIE SHERWOOD, declare that this statement is true to the best of my knowledge and belief and I make it knowing that if it is tendered in evidence at the Inquiry I will be liable to prosecution if I have wilfully stated in it anything which I know to be false or do not believe to be true.

1. The Inquiry has disclosed a number of documents to me. Where I make specific reference to a document in my statement I have given the number of the relevant page.
2. Detective Constable (DC) Keys spoke to me on 28<sup>th</sup> May 1997 as part of the Robert Hamill murder investigation. The notes of his conversation with me are contained at page 7773.
3. On the evening of 26 April 1997 I was working in Jameson's bar on Thomas Street. The bar is a public house, open to anybody, but it is usually Protestants who drink in there at night. In 1997, there was often trouble at the junction of Thomas Street and Market Street on an average Friday or Saturday night, with windows being broken and people shouting. The windows of Jameson's bar were broken many times. I do not know who was responsible for that. Sometimes there was shouting outside the bar but, by that time of night I had worked a shift of eight hours, it was the last thing on my mind. I worked at Jameson's between 1990 and 2005 but I never witnessed any fighting at the junction of Thomas Street and Market Street.
