R v LUNT AND OTHERS

DIANA HAMILL AND FIONA RYAN

The above two persons called to see me at my office at 2.30 pm on 3 November 1997.

Ms Hamill and Mrs Ryan are sisters of the deceased.

Mrs Ryan asked why the charges against three accused had been withdrawn. I informed her of the reasons - that evidence which had formed the basis of the police charges would no longer be available for any future prosecution.

Mrs Ryan stated that we had not spoken to all the witnesses. I asked what she meant. She stated that Mr Prunty had identified one of the defendants (Forbes) as being the person he saw kicking at Hamill and who was in the back of the police landrover.

I informed Mrs Ryan that this was not my understanding of the situation and that Mr Prunty had identified one of the other accused (not Forbes). I stated that this was a matter of some importance which I would need to consider and refer back to police.
