SALIENT POINTS EXTRACTED FROM THE INTERVIEW RECORD RELEVANT TO THIS ACTION: 1. ON SUNDAY 11/5/97, DC MCCRUMLISH ATTENDED CONFERENCE CHAIRED BY P39, STATES THAT D/C MCINTOSH AND HIMSELF WERE DIRECTED TO SEARCH THE HOME ADDRESS OF THOMAS HANVEY. 2. DC MCCRUMLISH NOTES THAT HE WAS BRIEFED THAT HANVEY HAD GONE TO THIS ADDRESS AFTER THE FIGHT AND THE PURPOSE OF THE SEARCH WAS TO LOCATE ANY CLOTHING THAT BELONGED TO ALISTAIR HANVEY AND WHICH MAY HAVE BEEN WORN BY HIM DURING THE INCIDENT, STATES THAT HE WAS ALSO BRIEFED TO SEARCH FOR A DARK COLOURED JACKET WITH GREY SLEEVES-STATES THAT HE WAS ALSO TOLD TO LOOK FOR EVIDENCE OF ANYTHING HAVING BEEN BURNT AT THE HOUSE. 3. D/C MCCRUMLISH STATES THAT ON CALLING AT THE ADDRESS, THEY INITIALLY INTERVIEWED AND RECORDED A WITNESS STATEMENT FROM THOMAS HANVEY (SEE A669) 4. D/C MCCRUMLISH STATES THAT AFTER THE INTERVIEW, THEY THEN SEARCHED THE ADDRESS WHICH WAS A SMALL OLD AGE PENSIONERS BUNGALOW WHICH WAS SPARSELY FURNISHED-STATES THAT HE SEARCHED EVERY ROOM AND IN PARTICULAR THE ROOM WHERE ALISTAIR HANVEY HAD SLEPT, HE ALSO STATES THAT HE CHECKED THE COATS IN THE HALL, THE FIREPLACE, THE BIN AND THE FRONT AND BACK GARDENS. 5. D/C MCCRUMLISH STATES THAT HE DID NOT FIND ANY CLOTHING AT THE ADDRESS BELONGING TO ALISTAIR HANVEY AND HE DID NOT FIND ANY EVIDENCE OF RECENTLY BURNED ITEMS-STATES THAT NOTHING WAS SEIZED AND RETAINED FROM THE SEARCH OF THOMAS HANVEY'S HOUSE.
