(COMMENTS: (A) ATKINSON'S CALL IS TIMED AT 8.37AM 27/4/97

(B) THEY MAKE NO MENTION OF RECEIVING THIS TELEPHONE CALL

(C) THEY MAKE NO MENTION OF MICHAEL MCKEE RINGING TO ENQUIRE ABOUT TRACY CLARKE

(D) FIRST CALL MADE FROM HANVEY'S H/A ON 27/4/97 IS TO T. HANVEY AT [REDACTED] AT 10.03AM (WHERE ALISTAIR HANVEY CLAIMS HE WAS OVERNIGHT)

(E) THEY DO NOT MENTION TRACY CLARKE WHEN KENNETH HANVEY SPEAKS TO ALISTAIR)

2. THE HANVEY'S STATE THAT ALISTAIR WAS WEARING A BLACK BOMBER JACKET-"CAT"

COMMENTS: (1) A POLICEMAN (R/CON WARNOCK) DESCRIBES HIM WEARING A BOMBER JACKET WITH GREY SLEEVES

(2) SEE S51 - EVIDENCE OF GREY TOP WITH ZIP

(3) SEE STATEMENT OF IRENE CLARKE REGARDING ALISTAIR HANVEY

BURNING THE JACKET WHICH TRACY CLARKE BOUGHT FOR HIM - ALSO SEE ENQUIRIES REGARDING "PARANOID" WHERE TRACY CLARKE PURCHASED A JACKET FOR ALISTAIR HANVEY.

3(A) THE HANVEY'S STATE THAT ALISTAIR HAD TOLD THEM ABOUT A POLICEMAN ASKING HIM TO ASSIST IN KEEPING THE CROWD BACK.

(B) MR HANVEY STATES THAT THIS POLICEMAN MAY GIVE EVIDENCE TO THIS EFFECT

(C) MR HANVEY REFUSED TO GIVE DETAILS OF THIS POLICEMAN.

COMMENTS: (1) TENDS TO INDICATE TAHT A. HANVEY DID SPEAK TO A POLICE OFFICER AT THE SCENE WHO HE KNEW.
