Accompanied by D/C/I K [REDACTED] interviewed Father Sean Dooley at [REDACTED] [REDACTED] Rough notes recorded by myself at the time attached. Father Dooley stated he received a call from a male person who he assumed was a Police officer because of his knowledge of the events of 27/04/97. He said this person appeared nervous and was calling from a call box. Father Dooley stated this person had tried to contact him earlier that night but he was out and was informed of this by someone else in his house. Father Dooley believes he received this call sometime around 9 pm - 9 16 pm approximately on 11th May 1997 a Sunday evening. The caller said there was 4 police officers in the landrover and they had been sleeping on duty. They had been on duty from 4 that day, were on overtime and didn't really want to be there. One of them owns a karate premises at Jameson Enterprises. A person called Handy was involved in this karate club and it was he who felled Robert Hamill. This person told Father Dooley that the police officers were wakened by two people who were with Robert Hamill and they (police) saw a person jumping on Robert's head - Stacey Bridgett - this first note implies that Police saw people - Handy - jumping on Robert's head and Stacey Bridgett's name was mentioned. The caller told Father Dooley that there was 3 men and 1 woman in the landrover and the woman was unable or useless to act. There was two weaklings in the town. The woman and one gentleman officer not Atkinson. He said they had been detailed to be there to protect the people from St Patrick's and their back up unit was out in the country and should have been in town but was not. Father Dooley said that [REDACTED] came to him about this call as Mrs [REDACTED] informed him the caller had told her that he had contacted Father Dooley. Mrs [REDACTED] came to him sometime in Oct 97 or early Nov 97. Father Dooley states he copied some of his notes he made and gave them to Mrs [REDACTED] We requested a copy of Father Dooley's notes however he was reluctant to give us them and wanted to speak to someone prior to giving them to police. Father Dooley stated this person wanted Father Dooley to go to the Sunday World, Father Dooley stated he wasn't doing that and the caller should do that if he wanted. On hearing the news the following day Father Dooley changed Handy to Hanvey.
