Further to your minute @ 67. The taped interviews of Const Neill, P/Const [Redacted] and Const Atcheson are currently being transcribed for submission to the Commission. It appears this is a lengthy process - so it may be a week or two before the transcripts arrive.

w/Const Cornett resumes duty on 29/9/97 and arrangements will be made to, hopefully, interview her that week. Perhaps you would nominate a time/date suitable for yourself to attend interview.

The investigation team intend to re-interview Const Atcheson re - his alleged involvement with Harvey. On your behalf, I advised that this aspect was outside the Commission's remit.

12/9/97. Interviews of Louis Jell.

R/Law [redacted] took place as arranged on 8/9/97 in Lisbon. Both were tape recorded - were quite lengthy. Louis Jell, as the full time officer, was in charge - some access as game - frank in the interviews.

R/Law [redacted] is apparently still off duty for a stress related problem, which prepared to be interviewed. was obviously very nervous - far from clear in her responses. He seems to have spent most of his time with his back to the scene the Federal Substation.

attended both interviews.

R. Law Alkins was interviewed on 9/9/97 in the presence of Mr. Sec 8/97. He was quite impressive in his answers - gave considerable detail, complying that the Police had been given a bad press by the Media without any opportunity to respond. He maintains that there was just insufficient man power initially to deal with the the situation which had developed suddenly. - five officers including a woman R/Law, and they had done everything possible before the arrival of support.

He was also questioned about post-incident involvement with Stanley & contact whatsoever.
