4. I don't know now who I was with on 26/27 April 1997 neither can I remember who was on the bus when we arrived back in Portadown. The bus stopped at the bottom of the town near Bridge Street because the barriers were across the bottom of High Street. I got off near Herrons Chip Shop and walked up the High Street towards my home in the Brownstown Estate. I believe I walked along the Woodhouse Street side of the High Street. Several mates got off the bus and zoomed straight on up the town but I do not remember who they are now.
5. I would have walked across the junction of Woodhouse Street with High Street into Market Street and then into West Street. I do not remember seeing a Police Land Rover whilst walking through the town.
6. I do remember seeing my cousin Lisa Hobson somewhere near the summer seats in front of the church I think she was with a few girls bit I'm not sure. I have been asked if I knew Heidi Reaney, I did know a Reaney family who lived on my estate but I cannot remember seeing her. I do know a Joanne Bradley but cannot remember seeing her. I do not know either a Michelle Jamieson or Wayne Lunt.
7. In my statement [page 9170] I said, "*When I moved on home I saw the police in the town.*" I cannot remember now where exactly I saw the police they must have been driving around whilst I was walking home. I continued on home and went to bed. It would take me about twenty minutes to walk home from where I got off the bus if I walked quickly.
8. Whilst walking through the town centre I cannot remember seeing a fight or anyone on the ground near the junction of High Street with Thomas Street. I had heard that it was a problem area in Woodhouse Street where the Catholics walked from St Patrick's Hall in Thomas Street across High Street down under the tunnel in Woodhouse street. I have never personally seen or been involved in any fighting in the town centre.

9. In 1997 I knew a girl called Tracey McAlpine she lived just around the corner from my home. I think I have been to her house once for a drink after being out on a Saturday night. I also knew a girl called Tracey Clarke. Tracey Clarke referred to a Dennis from Brownstown in her statement [Page 262] as being at Tracey McAlpine's on 27 April 1997. She probably was referring to me but I cannot remember going to Tracey McAlpine's house that night.
10. I did know Tracey's boyfriend Allister Hanvey from going about in the town but we weren't good friends.
11. I was working at 9.0am on Sunday 27 April 1997 and caught a taxi to work that is why I don't think I went to a party at Tracey McAlpine's but I cannot truthfully remember if I did or not.
12. Whilst at work on Sunday 27 April 1997 I heard on the radio that there had been a fight in the town centre and subsequently heard that Robert Hamill died as a result of that fight. I cannot recall discussing the incident at any stage after going out on 26/27 April 1997.
13. Sometime later in the year, 1997, I went to a Band Parade with a lot of other people from Portadown on the way back we went and visited those people who were in prison for being involved in the death of Robert Hamill. I visited Marc Hobson. I knew him to talk to and have the occasional drink with. We all went in to keep their morale up I don't know who visited who just that I went and saw Marc. I don't know who arranged the visits. I cannot remember discussing the fight with Marc it was just general conversation.
14. I only visited Marc Hobson but I do know Stacey Bridgett who lived in the same road as me, he is a year older than me I think. I also know Dean Forbes who lived on my estate to say hello to. I cannot remember seeing either Stacey or Dean on the night of 26/27 April 1997.

15. I also knew Andrew Allen whose nickname was 'Fonzy' I used to knock around with him. Similarly I knew Davy Woods. But I did not know Rory Robinson. I cannot recall seeing them on night 26/27 April 1997.

16. I knew Pauline Newell the sister of Tracey McAlpine and her friend Kelly Lavery. I went to school with Timothy Jameson but I cannot remember seeing any of these people on 26/27 April 1997 as I have said previously I had drunk probably two bottles of Buckfast Tonic Wine that night and was drunk.

17. The police did come to see me on 15 January 2001 and asked me about Allister Hanvey I told them that I knew Allister but didn't see him or anyone else on the night of 26/27 April 1997.

18. I have no information about the conduct of the police on the night as I can only recall seeing police vehicles on my way home. I have no memory of seeing officers in the High Street or any police vehicle in that area. Neither do I have any information from discussing the incident with other people.
