FURTHER INTERIM DIRECTION

I refer to my Interim Direction dated 27 February 1998 in this matter.

In order that all relevant and available evidence may be before the Director to assist in coming to a decision in this matter D/Ch/Supt McBurney should write to [REDACTED] Solicitor for Diane Hamill, informing her of the present position and that the Director has requested that she be asked whether she is aware of the identity of any person or persons who may have evidence to give in relation to the events at Market Street/High Street, Portadown on 27 April 1997, but who have not made witness statements to police in relation thereto.

Additionally, Ms [REDACTED] should be requested, if she is aware of any such person or persons, to provide such details in respect of them as would enable police to approach them with a view to recording witness statements from them.

If such statements become available they should be forwarded to this office under cover of a report as soon as possible.

D/C/Supt McBurney should, in any event, report on the outcome of these further enquiries.
