This interview is being tape recorded. The interview is being conducted in an interview room at Lurgan Police Station. I am [REDACTED] of Portadown Police Station. The other police officer present is [REDACTED], CID Lurgan. The date is Sunday the 11th of May 1997 and the time from my watch now is 10.27am.

What is your full name.

ROBINSON Rory Randolph Arthur Robinson.

And how old are you Rory.

ROBINSON Twenty five.

And where do you live.

Rory at the conclusion of this interview I will give to you a notice explaining what will happen to the tapes. Do you understand that Rory.

ROBINSON

Yes.

Rory it was approximately 7.40pm on Saturday the 10th of May 1997 you were arrested in Portadown on suspicion of being involved in the murder of Robert Hamill and also for the offence of grievous bodily harm against D [REDACTED]. Is that correct.

ROBINSON

Yes.

Before I can put questions to you I have to caution you and the caution is as follows. You do not have to say anything, but I must caution you that if you do not mention when questioned something which you later rely on in court, it may harm your defence. If you do say anything it may be given in evidence. Do

you understand that caution.

ROBINSON Yes.

Or do you want me to explain it to you.

ROBINSON No.

Also you are entitled to legal representation which is also present here in the form of [REDACTED]. Rory for the purposes of the record you had an interview late last night and due to the fact that you have slept during the night and here we are now, are there any things that you want to change.

ROBINSON No.

Is there anything that you may have thought of that you, that wasn't at hand last night during the interview.

ROBINSON No.

None at all.

So just for the purposes of the record, I will quickly recap what you said last night and that was basically you went to the Coach in Banbridge via bus, you sat on your own on the front seat, you didn't speak to nobody, you didn't recognise anybody. Is that correct.

ROBINSON Yes.

Except for [REDACTED] who you paid your fare to. You arrived at the Coach and met your girlfriend there, Clare Glover from [REDACTED] You both went to the Coach together, you met nobody from the Portadown area, you socialised with nobody from Portadown, is that correct.

ROBINSON Yes.

At the end of the evening you boarded your bus and Clare boarded her bus, the Lurgan bus.
