Introduction made, Miss P39 informed as to the nature of our enquiries.</p> <p>Salient points of note which are relevant to the Atkinson Investigation: -</p> <p>A588 - Miss P39 was off duty on 8 May 1997 - On her return to duty on morning of 9 May 1997 she recalls being briefed by DI [redacted] or DC M'Allee ref. information given by a woman. She believed that this was Andrea M'Kee. She recalled that this info. concerned the murder of Mr. Harold and the allegation that R/Cat Atkinson had sent a suspect called Harvey telling him to burn his clothes. She first met Andrea M'Kee when M'Kee accompanied Tracy Clarke to the police station on night of 9 May 1997 to be interviewed. She recalled that Andrea M'Kee was the aunt of Tracy Clarke who was the girlfriend of the suspect Harvey. Miss P39 could not recall how the arrangement was made for Tracy Clarke to attend the police station but thinks DC M'Allee arranged it, she recalled that it was very late on that night as Tracy was working at a Chinese restaurant - She had never spoken to M'Kee before this.</p> <p>A614 - Miss P39 remembered that R/Cat M'Caule had some involvement in passing the information from Andrea M'Kee to the investigator Yeaman but she was off duty on 8 May and wasn't herself involved at that time - She was not aware at that time of the meeting with Andrea M'Kee at Kernan and involving DI [redacted] and DC M'Allee. On her return to duty the following morning, she recalls being told about R/Cat Atkinson. She recalls saying that</p>

due to the nature of the allegations against Atkinson, that this had to be dealt with extremely sensitively - DCs McBurney, DP Wain, DC McAtee and herself were the only people that knew of it. Sharon Rice recalled the report which she remembered telling DC McAtee to hand write due to sensitivity - she believed that this report for telephone billing was made to Headquarters that day (on 9 May 1997).

- Miss P39 even that officer had been called in to duty to prepare statements - she does not recall speaking to Atkinson on morning of the incident accordingly.

- In October 1997, Miss P39 on other duties in Belfast - was not involved at the stage when Tracy Clarke retraced his evidence.

A643 - States that when Tracy Clarke was interviewed, Andrea McKea, DC McAtee and herself were present, - DC McAtee recorded the statement - states that Andrea McKea was present throughout the taking of the statement from beginning to end - states that Andrea McKea was very helpful in getting Tracy to the police station and was supportive to Tracy during the interviews - Miss P39 states that Andrea McKea was present when Tracy told them about what Anton Henry had told her (Tracy) about Atkinson saying him and telling her to burn his clothes - Miss P39 shown copy of Tracy Clarke's statement dated 10/5/97 and that part of it dealing with the allegation concerning Atkinson - states that Andrea McKea was present and made no comments at all when this was discussed with Tracy Clarke - states that she recalls her DC McAtee and herself left Tracy Clarke home - early hours of 10/5/97 - recalls speaking to Tracy's mother and father at that time - Miss P39 states that she does not recall speaking to Andrea McKea

again after that - has never visited
 M'Lee's M/A in [redacted] - has never met
 or spoke to Michael M'Lee - doesn't
 know him. The issue of Andrea M'Lee
 providing an alibi statement to cover
 the phone call for K/la Atkinson which
 was made by her on 29/10/97 was
 discussed. Miss P39 states that
 she was not aware of this at that stage
 she was working in Belfast - states that
 the only involvement that she had in
 the investigation of the Atkinson
 allegation involved getting phone
 bills - states that her recollection is
 that this matter was discussed with
 Mr [redacted] of the ICPC and it was
 decided at that point that DES M'Barney
 would investigate the allegation
 concerning Atkinson - shown copy of
 RI - Miss P39 confirmed that this
 was her handwriting - states that as far
 as she can recall, this was the only
 telephone numbers that she appeared for
 at that time - Miss P39 was reminded
 as to what the 4 numbers referred to.

A918 - Cannot recall why she also appeared for
 [redacted] (Gurton) - Miss P39
 said that she would have to think about
 this and recollect her thoughts as to the
 reason why she appeared for that number.
 Recalled advising the results and making
 this on a letter which was placed on
 HOLMES - states that she had nothing more to
 do with this element of the investigation as
 this was being investigated by DES M'Barney.

A635 - Has no knowledge whatsoever of anonymous
 phone calls being made to Father
 Dooley or [redacted] - states that
 she recalls speaking to Father [redacted]
 regarding concerns from the community in
 the initial stages of the investigation -
 states that Father [redacted] was mentioned
 or told her about this.
