For your convenience, please find attached the voice log transcript for the call taken on 27 April 1997 at 01.49 hours. There was no indication on this tape that an earlier call had been received.

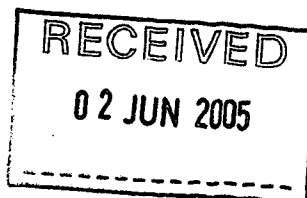
