All the above are required before any decisions as to prosecution can or will be taken in this case.

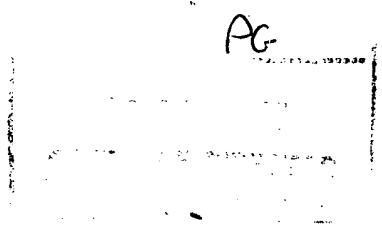
Finally, I note reference is made by both the investigating officer and P39 to a separate report in a sealed envelope reference Witnesses A and B.
