## DIRECTION - PART I

### CHARGES:

Prosecute James Michael McKee on indictment for the following non-scheduled offence:-

1. That you, on the 9th day of October 1997, in the County Court Division of Craigavon, with intent to pervert the course of public justice did an act which had a tendency to pervert the course of public justice in that, when asked by a police officer about a telephone call made from a certain house on 27 April 1997 at 8.37 am, you gave false information to the police officer that you had made the telephone call, contrary to Common Law. 00.00.000

Prosecute Andrea Louise McKee on indictment for the following non-scheduled offence:-

2. That you, on the 29th day of October 1997, in the County Court Division of Craigavon, with intent to pervert the course of public justice did an act which had a tendency to pervert the course of public justice in that, when asked by a police officer about a telephone call made from a certain house on 27 April 1997 at 8.37 am, you gave false information to the police officer that it had been Michael McKee, your husband, who had made the telephone call, contrary to Common Law. 00.00.000


### GENERAL:

Primary prosecution disclosure will be made to the defence following committal. Copies of the disclosure letter and marked non-sensitive schedule are enclosed.

Committal papers, Directions for committal proceedings, the police investigation file and a copy Direction Part I have been handed to the police officer in charge of the case and he should deal with them in compliance with RUC Force instructions.

The Senior Law Clerk, Eastern Circuit, will be sent, inter alia, copy Part I of this Direction, Direction Part II, copy Directions for committal proceedings and letters and enclosures to be given to the Disclosure Officer at the time the committal papers are checked and copy police report.

The District Commander Craigavon, Royal Ulster Constabulary, Lurgan has now been sent a copy Direction Part I and copy Directions for committal proceedings.
