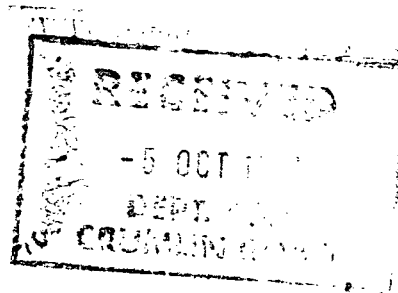

Please note the following:-

1. Disclosure has not been fully made in this case by the Crown. In particular my letter of the 12th August and paragraph (2) thereof has not been complied with in anyway whatsoever.
2. Paragraph (4) of my letter of the 12th August 1998 has not been complied with in full.
3. Detective Sergeant Bradley has promised to disclose a further statement from Mr Prunty and this is still awaited.
4. I still await a third copy of each of the maps and photographs - reference my letter 23rd September 1998.
5. The "night time photographs of Portadown Centre, S522/9" have not been sent to me.

I require full Disclosure of all working papers, notes, further reports obtained for any matters arising whatsoever concerning the Post Mortem report and further investigations concerning the death of Robert Hamill. It became apparent during various remand hearings that further enquiries were being made and in particular reference was made in vague terms to sending samples to England. Dr [redacted] on behalf of the Defence requires all such materials forthwith. In addition he also
