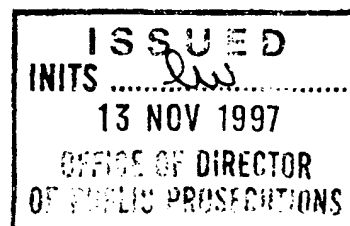
MURDER OF ROBERT HAMILL

1. For information (and discussion if you require it) I enclose Senior Counsel's advices.
2. I have previously spoken to G Kerr QC at length about the case and in particular the evidence against Lunt. Counsel advises that given the evidence now of Mr Prunty there is no reasonable prospect of a conviction of Lunt for an offence of murder of Hamill. This is and has been my view. I will now proceed to have Lunt released from custody as soon as possible.
3. Mr Kerr has advised further enquiries in regard to Forbes, and Bridgett and Hobson. I will have these attended to by Mr Davison.
4. Professor Crane has provided (as of yesterday) his post-mortem report. The cause of death is stated as
 - 1(a) Diffuse brain injury associated with fracture of skull due to
 - (b) Blows to head.
