Travelled to Wrexham Police
Station with DCI K
Present when DCI K
met with DCI and
Catherine Jagger Solicitor.
Circumstances of case briefing
outlined by DCI. Told Andrea
McKee was to be interviewed
after caution re conspiracy
to pervert the course of justice
later today. McKee would
be reported to the DPP should
admissions be made. It was
intended to ask McKee if she
would give evidence on
behalf of the Crown
against the other conspirators
when she would be dealt
with for her part in the
conspiracy - Mrs Jagger
indicated willingness to
represent McKee if elected
by McKee to do so.

Mrs Jagger told DCI she would require disclosure of pre interview material for consultation with McKee

1 30 pm Called at [REDACTED]
Wrexham home address of Andrea McKee no reply.
Curtains pulled over

2 40 pm Further call at [REDACTED]
[REDACTED] - no reply position unchanged.

3 20 pm Called at [REDACTED]
with DCI ^K[REDACTED]
admitted by Andrea McKee
Introduced myself to her.
Already aware of DCI ^K[REDACTED]
identity. Told by DCI it was intended to interview her at Wrexham after caution re her involvement in the conspiracy
She said this was always going to happen and wanted the whole thing cleared up once and for all so that she could get on with her life. She knew they had

done wrong and that it
would never go away.
She asked about the others
Told were all under
arrest and being interviewed
at this time. She was
told it was intended to
report her to the DPP for
her part in the conspiracy.
She indicated she had
decided sometime ago to
tell the truth and thats
what she was going to do.
Was asked if she would
give evidence against the
others when she was
dealt with by the DPP.
She said she had no fear
in telling the truth and
would give evidence against
the others. She was asked
about her solicitor. She
replied "Do I need one"
Told it would be better
to have legal representation.
DCI informed her he

had consulted with a
local solicitor who had previous
experience with this type of
case. McKee asked if
we could arrange this solicitor
for her. It was agreed
McKee would attend
Wrexham Police Station at
4 30 pm.

3 30 pm Left Andrea McKees home
Returned to Wrexham Police
Station.

Ombudsman representation
briefed by DCI.

4 30 pm Informed Andrea McKee
had arrived at Wrexham
enquiry office. Brought
to Solicitor Room for
consultation with Catherine Jagger
Contacted Sgt Workman Banbridge
for details required for
Voluntary Attender and
gave details of interview
to him.

Following consultation between
Andrea McKee and Catherine

Jagger Solicitor came to
interview room.

Ombudsman representation
introduced him to Mrs Jagger
and left with Mrs [REDACTED]
following a short conversation.
