Parked at Instep then proceeded
down High Street when I
observed a male in his
late 30's early 40's and
wearing blue shirt and
dark trousers looking at
me and moving his lips.
I opened the landrover
door and the man said

"My friends are coming down
Thomas Street". I replied
"OK". He then proceeded down
Woodhouse Street. 2
youths males both in
late teens early 20's came
over to me at the landrover
and started to talk to me.
One male wearing a Ralph
Loren shirt blue in colour
short brown hair. He had
a green glass bottle of cider
in his right hand. The
other person was wearing

a light cream shirt, dark
trousers and brown short
hair. They were from
Portadown. They had local
accents. Constables Neill's
door opened and a man
aged approximately late 30's
wearing blue/green shirt
dark trousers, brown short
hair was standing shouting
at us. We got out of
~~the landrover and there~~
were several fights in
progress and a lot of
shoutings. Women were
screaming. I ran back
to the landrover and I
called for assistance. I
then had to call for a
ambulance as there were 2
casualties. There was a
female shouting at me
and screaming. I ran over
to 1 of the casualties he
was wearing a blue shirt
dark jeans and short brown

hair to see if he was breathing. 2 females were present. One of the females was wearing a black leather jacket, dark trousers and long streaked hair. The other female had brown hair short. I then immediately went over to the other casualties and he was unconscious. A female came to me and she was distressed. She was wearing blue jacket and dark trousers and short dark auburn hair. I observed Constable Neill struggling with a young male at the landrover. I tried to help Const Neill but a male 20's early wearing white top and brown wavy hair trying to kick the male which Const Neill was trying to talk to. I pulled this person away from Const Neill

direction. A male wearing
blue shirt pulled this male
towards Alliance & Leicester.
I was approached by
a female wearing blue jacket
dark trousers I had spoke
to her earlier was very
distressed I tried to
comfort her. At this
point the ambulance arrived
took the 2 casualties.

~~We were requested to~~

move the crowd. We
then formed a line (police).
Approximately 50 Protestants
and 10 Catholics. We
then moved the Protestants
to West Street Barrier
and we remained there.
