

Capt. Cooke - Saw [redacted] at front of crowd. (This was about 5 minutes after the assaults occurred).

[redacted] wearing black leather jacket & blue denim trousers.
[redacted] requested by Capt. Cooke to move back on several occasions but refused to move. [redacted] in company of Roy Robinson.

Capt. Neill - May refer to [redacted] 27. Description of person who kicked Hamill as he lay on ground

Late 20's, Round face with goatee beard.

Very short hair

Leather type soft casual wintercoat.

Struck on leg by baton by Capt. Neill.

This person was standing with Roy Robinson.

STACY BRIDGETT

R/Const. Cornett - She was talking to Bridgett & Dean Forbes just before incident? Stacy was wearing a blue Ralph Lauren shirt.

R/Const. Silcock - Woman wearing white top (F [redacted]) pointed out to him, a youth who jumped on the head of one of the injured men. This person was wearing a charcoal top and had blood coming from his nose. A member of the crowd referred to him as Stacy, and this person responded to same.

* F [redacted] has no recollection of pointing this person out to R/Const Silcock.

R/Const. P40 [redacted] 1-43 am. - He was talking to Stacy along with R/Const. Cornett, before incident occurred. Stacy accompanied by one other unknown male youth.

R/Const. Atkinson - Saw Victoria Clayton, of [redacted] wiping blood off Stacy Bridgett

Det. Neill. - Stacy was carrying a bottle of "Older English" cider when he was talking to police before incident.

Const. A [redacted] - Seen Stacy Bridgett after incident. - He was wearing a cream shirt with fine brown stripe over white jeans. He had blood coming from his nose.

Cont. Neill :- @ Forbes was in the company of Stacy Bridgett. He describes Forbes as being 5'9", thin build, short brown hair. He said to Cont. Neill that he was a painter.

Cont. A : - Saw Dean Forbes, was seen in the crowd, he was wearing a light colored check shirt over cream colored trousers.
