1) Can you outline your movements for the evening of Saturday 26th early hours of Sunday 27th April 1997 who was in your company?
At Coach and I got, I think it was an Ulsterbus, home to Portadown outside Z Cabs. I walked with Shelly Liggett and a few mates ie Jason Woods, Pauline Newell and a few others were walking behind. I was at the Winemark when I was aware of sirens and blue flashing lights down town and I thought something must have been happening but it wasn't until the next day that I heard what had happened.

2a) Were you in vicinity of the scene of the incident?

I walked up the town before the incident about ten to two or slightly after it.


2b) Do you know R/Constable Atkinson?

I only found out after the incident when I heard his name I was told he lived on the Brownstown Road.

2c) Did you speak to him at the scene?

No I didn't speak to any police.

3) Were you at a party at Tracy McAlpine's house later that evening


I left a friend called Shelly Liggett at the house after the Coach. I went into the house for about 3 or 4 minutes. I left her there as she was to get the taxi from there. I went home on my own straight after.

4) What time did you arrive?

About 10 past, a quarter past two. It all depends what time the bus is in at.

5) Who did you arrive with?

I arrived with Shelly Liggett.

6) At the party do you recall any person with injuries.

I wasn't aware there was a party. There was no party going on when I arrived. I don't recall any persons with injuries.

7) What were the injuries and what was discussed in relation to them.

8) Did you see a person called Groggs at the party. What do you know about him.

He's my cousin. Gregory Blevins is his real name. He would be a close friend of mine. To tell you the truth I don't even think he was at the Coach.

9) Do you recall Allister Hanvey at the party?

No, he wasn't at the house in my time. I was one of the first ones off the bus to get up the town and home.

10) When did he arrive?

I don't know.

11) Whose company was he in?

I couldn't honestly tell you to tell you the truth.

12) Did you speak to him at the party and what was discussed?

No.

13) Did he talk about the incident earlier, what did he say about it?

No I wasn't talking to him.

I was probably with him most of the night, but due to the passing of time I can't remember what he was wearing.
