SUBJECT: WITNESS PROTECTION PROGRAMME -
ANDREA McKEE (NÉE [REDACTED])

On Tuesday 27.1.04 I travelled to the above named person's address in Wrexham, North Wales. I was accompanied by D/Constable [REDACTED] who is part of the investigation team.

Whilst there I explained to Mrs McKee that she met the criteria for inclusion within the PSNI Witness Protection Programme, however if she was to be included she would have to move some distance away from her present address as we had concerns for her safety if she were to remain in the Wrexham area. She stated that in the circumstances she fully understood and appreciated our concerns and would like to discuss the situation with her partner and family.

D/Constable [REDACTED] discussed other options with the subject and that a move could be facilitated within the Wrexham area with the cooperation of local police and contacts within the local agencies.

The subject expressed concerns that all her commitments with work and family were situated within the Wrexham area, both for herself and her partner, and that they would have to give careful consideration to all options before making up their minds.

Subsequently I have now been informed by D/Constable [REDACTED] that Andrea McKee will not be availing of the Witness Protection Programme due to her commitments within the Wrexham area. He has also informed me that she wishes to move house in the Wrexham area, which will be facilitated by investigating police in cooperation with the local police in Wrexham and that other measures will be looked at to try and ensure their safety.

I would recommend we retain all reports in respect of this referral and should circumstances change in the near future then the mechanisms are already in place to have an operation commenced at short notice.
