Purpose

The items submitted were examined for bloodstaining.

Findings

My examination has been conducted with the assistance of scientific support staff. A full record of the work undertaken is contained within the case notes made at the time of examination and these are available for inspection.

Items attributed to Allister Hanvey

Item 87 (BDS4) consisted of a polo shirt. A number of red/brown stains were found on the front of the shirt. The shirt was visually and chemically examined for blood. None was found.

Item 88 (BDS5) consisted of a white, red and black football shirt. A number of red/brown stains were found on the shirt. The shirt was visually and chemically examined for blood. None was found.

Items attributed to Robert Atkinson

Item 89 (JDMcC25) consisted of a police issue baton.

Item 90 (JDMcC27) consisted of a pair of a pair of black boots. They were visually and chemically examined for blood. None was found.

Item 91 (JDMcC28) consisted of two green V-necked police issue pullovers. They were visually and chemically examined for blood. None was found.

Item 92 (JDMcC29) consisted of a police issue shirt. It was visually and chemically examined for blood. None was found.

Item 93 (JDMcC30) consisted of a police issue waterproof jacket. It was visually and chemically examined for blood. None was found.

Item 94 (JDMcC31) consisted of two police issue waterproof jackets. They were visually and chemically examined for blood. None was found.

Item 95 (JDMcC32) consisted of two pairs of police issue trousers. One of the pairs of trousers had a belt. These items were visually and chemically examined for blood. None was found.

Item 96 (JDMcC33) consisted of an RUC uniform tunic. It was visually and chemically examined for blood. None was found.
