On Saturday 26 April 1997 I left Portadown and got the bus to the Coach Inn in Banbridge, I was with Christopher Smith and Richard Cassells from Rectory. We travelled to Banbridge and went to the Coach. It was about 1 or 1 15 when we got the bus back to Portadown arriving about 1 40 am. The bus dropped us off at the bottom of the town. I got off the bus on my own and walked up the town. There was a lot of people got off the bus at the same time. I would say about half the bus load did about 20 or 30 people. I was one of the first off the bus and walked on, a lot of the others were hanging about around Boss Hoggs. I walked on up through the town. I saw a Police landrover beside the bank or the Alliance & Leicester. There was no one about at the top end of the town or indeed around the area of the landrover. I walked on up the town. I heard noises coming from behind me but I thought it was boy only carrying on that was it I just walked on home. I didn't see anything at all unusual. I'm not too sure but I think I was wearing a red or blue shirt, jeans and a navy bomber jacket. I arrived home shortly before 2 am.
