by whom statement was recorded or received

I was the Casualty Officer (MB BCh FRCS) on duty in the Accident and Emergency Department of Craigavon Area Hospital in the early hours of the 27th of April 1997 when Mr Robert Hamill was brought in unconscious by the ambulance. He was allegedly assaulted by a crowd of approximately nine people. He was totally unconscious when he was brought in. His vital sign was stable, his pupils were responding to light. However, he would only move his right foot with pain. His airway was partially obstructed and his jaw was in spasm. He was not maintaining sufficient oxygen saturation. He was immediately bagged with 100% oxygen through mask. An anaesthetist was immediately summoned and arrived promptly. The patient was intubated by the anaesthetist. Cervical collar was put on and large venflows inserted prior to transfer to the Neurosurgical Unit in the Royal Victoria Hospital.
