I am a Constable of the Royal Ulster Constabulary presently attached to Portadown. Further to my statement regarding serious public disorder which occurred on Sunday 27 April 1997 in Portadown town centre. I have already made reference to placing Wayne Lunt, DOB [REDACTED] into the rear of the landrover to ascertain his name and address. This was done at approximately 0157 hours, Mr Lunt left the police landrover at 0205 hours. At this time I was approached by a male person approximately 5'9" in height, he was wearing light coloured trousers, blue shirt and tie, he had short ginger/fair hair. This person started to shout at me, "What the fuck did you let him go for, he was one of the ones that did it." I took it that this person was referring to the two male persons who were lying motionless in the road. I now know that these persons were Robert Hamill and D [REDACTED]. I tried to explain to this person my reasons for releasing Lunt, but he was continually aggressive and constantly shouting at me. Another male who was about 5'7" in height of stocky build and had short dark hair, this person was civil and asked me if he could take my name with reference to the assault and disorder, I agreed and gave him my name.
