SIGNATURE OF WITNESS

I am a Constable of the Royal Ulster Constabulary presently attached to Portadown RUC Station. Further to my statements dated 27th April 1997 and 24th June 1997 I can state that when Wayne Lunt was placed in the back of the landrover I got in with him. R/Const Warnock was in the landrover with me for a short period but left again. During this time the landrover rear doors would have been opened and closed. Whilst in the landrover I was in contact via radio with Portadown RUC Station in order to confirm Wayne Lunt's identity. It was as soon as Wayne Lunt was released from the landrover that I was approached by the male and I was in no doubt that he was referring to Lunt. At no time, when Lunt was in the landrover was there any other person placed in the landrover. I am not aware of any other person, besides Lunt, being placed in the landrover. In relation to Dean Forbes I have known him from the end of 1992. I did not see Dean Forbes at or near the landrover whilst I was there. I did see him in the crowd whenever they were being moved back. He wasn't wearing a scarf and the only one that I had dealings with who was wearing a scarf was Wayne Lunt.
