SIGNATURE OF WITNESS

I am a Constable in the Royal Ulster Constabulary presently stationed in Banbridge RUC Station, County Down. On Saturday 10th May 1997 I was on duty in uniform in Portadown RUC Station. At approximately 7 am with other police I attended a briefing given by CID in relation to a search at [REDACTED], Portadown for clothing and trainers. This was the home of an Alister Hanvey who was to be arrested in relation to the murder of Patrick Hamill in Portadown. I was detailed as part of a search team with Constable Porter. Sergeant Bingham was team leader and Constable P34 was log keeper. The search team was admitted to the house at 7 21 am and the search commenced. At the termination of the search Alister Hanvey was arrested and the team left the house at 7 46 am. The note book I was using at this time has since been lost in transit since my transfer from Mahon Road to Banbridge. I referred to a copy of the search log to obtain these details.
