I am a Detective Constable of the Royal Ulster Constabulary presently attached to the Criminal Investigation Department, South Region. On 11 May 1997 accompanied by Detective Constable [REDACTED] I carried out a search of [REDACTED] for shoes and jackets belonging to Rory Randolph Arthur Robinson. Both Robinson's parents were present during the search. I discussed with Mrs Robinson the items of clothing we were looking for. Mrs Robinson stated that she believed the jacket that we were looking for was at present being washed in the washing machine. Mrs Robinson stated that her son, Rory had asked her to wash it. I arranged to collect this jacket from Mrs Robinson later that evening. Detective Constable [REDACTED] seized several pairs of shoes and jackets. The search commenced at 2 31 pm and terminated at 2 46 pm. I then conveyed Detective Constable [REDACTED] and the property seized to Lurgan RUC Station. At 3 32 pm the same date I was present in interview room number 3 at Lurgan RUC Station along with Detective Constables [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] when Detective Constable [REDACTED] produced items marked CID1 to CID11 to Rory Randolph Arthur Robinson. [REDACTED] Solicitor was also present. At approximately 8 pm the same evening I returned to

[REDACTED] and spoke to Mrs Robinson who handed me a bomber type jacket with the words "CHEVIGON" printed on the jacket. I took possession of this jacket and bagged and labelled it EH8. On 12 May 1997 I handed item EH8 to Detective Constable McDowell.
