I am a Detective Constable of the Royal Ulster Constabulary presently attached to the Criminal Investigation Department, South Region. On Sunday 11 May 1997 accompanied by D/Constable McCrumlish I went to the home of Thomas Hanvey at [REDACTED]. I was in possession of a search warrant to search that address. We entered the house at 11 55 am on Mr Hanvey's invitation. I recorded a witness statement from him.
