I am a Detective Constable of the Royal Ulster Constabulary GC, presently attached to the Criminal Investigation Department, South Region. On Tuesday 13th May 1997 at 1150 hrs I spoke with Christopher Henderson, [REDACTED] at his home. I asked him about his movements after 2 am on 27th April 1997. He told me he had stayed at the bottom of the town (Portadown), talking until around 3 am then he walked up through the town with Ian Carville, [REDACTED] looking for a party. They went to [REDACTED] in [REDACTED] (exact address not known); [REDACTED] was either not in or asleep so they didn't get in. They walked from there round to Tracey McAlpine's in [REDACTED] - (exact address again not known but described [REDACTED]) - he used to go out with her, getting to her house at approximately 5 am in the morning. There were about 5 people in the living room, some more were asleep upstairs, he didn't know whom but Tracey McAlpine was apparently in bed asleep/sick. In the living room were Alister Hanvey, P46, possibly Dean Forbes (unsure) and a girl Kelly Lavery. There was no talk about the fight but he believed that it might have been mentioned casually, but no talk of who did what or anything

specific. Kelly Lavery was sleeping and someone painted her face with make up, there was some talk and laughter about this which resulted in her waking up, she was very annoyed and everybody was thrown out. Henderson walked back through the town with Alister Hanvey, and they got a taxi from Z Cabs up home. He went on to say that possibly Jason McClure (Jasey) from [REDACTED] may have been there but that he could be wrong, it might have been another weekend, he was drunk and most weekends are very similar. He couldn't say what Alister Hanvey was wearing that night, he thought it may have been jeans and jacket, nor could he remember what he himself was wearing either.
