I am an Inspector in the Royal Ulster Constabulary presently attached to Community Affairs Branch. On Sunday 27 April 1997 I was the Night Duty Inspector attached to Portadown RUC station. Further to my original statement relating to my policing responsibilities and management of the circumstances around the death of Mr Robert Hamill I would wish to make the following statement. After I arrived at the scene of the incident at Market Street and after having taken steps to initially deal with the incident. I had occasion to speak with R/Constable R Atkinson in Market Street convenient to were the police landrover that R/Constable Atkinson had been in. An officer proffered me his police issue baton which upon examination I observed that the strap had broken. Due to the passage of time I cannot recall previously what explanation he gave me around why the baton strap had been broken.
