I am an employee of Call-A-Cab at [REDACTED]. In April 1997 I was employed in Call-A-Cab as an operator in the office. I have been shown a document by H [REDACTED] which I recognise as a document I completed on the 27th April 1997. This is sheets completed by myself in respect of calls carried out by Call-A-Cab taxis. I recognise my writing and also the writing of [REDACTED] who would have been working with me however she seems to have made the majority of entries from 3 00 am onwards while I made the majority prior to 3 00 am. These documents commence at 1230 and the top of the page is marked 26/04/97. The reason for this is because we count Saturday nights from 6 pm to 3 00 am on Sunday morning. I have been shown in particular an entry timed at 2 15 to [REDACTED] to collect someone called Smith to take them to town and the driver is driver number 9 who was Alf Annesley. I can state that I made this entry as it is in my handwriting. Our sheets are usually made out prior to commencing that shift. By this I mean the pages are ruled and times inserted on the left of the page. Usually every 15 minutes. The entry for Smith to [REDACTED] is exactly on the 2 15 line which indicates to me that Smith was to be collected from [REDACTED] at 2 15. On checking the sheets the previous call that

driver No. 9 who is Alf Annesley did was to collect a fare from the cinema at Banbridge and drop it at the town and Craigavon which means Portadown town and somewhere in Craigavon. The fare is in the name of Kerr. It appears he collected this fare at around 1 40 am on 27/04/97. This entry was completed by [REDACTED]. This collection from Banbridge would have been pre booked and pre paid. I am unable to say at what time the booking for Smith was made.
