In 1997 I can't recall the exact date I can remember however it was the night Robert Hamill got the beating in Portadown. I had been to the Coach Inn disco in Banbridge and travelled home in the bus. I got the bus outside the Coach around 1 30 am and got of in Portadown around 2 am. I was very drunk and I remember calling into Boss Hoggs it a burger shop. I got something to eat. I came outside and saw a fight up at the corner of Thomas St. I didn't take much interest in the fight. I started talking to this middle aged woman. She was standing in the doorway of Wellworths. I saw the police at the fight they appeared to be breaking the fight up. I walked up towards the fight and saw one man lying on the ground. He sounded as though he was having an asthma attack. The police were giving him attention. There was all people standing about, but I can't remember who they were. I think I was along with Christopher Henderson. We walked up the town to this house in [REDACTED] I wasn't sure of the address. There was a young girl Pauline in the house, Dean Forbes, Ally Hanvey maybe [REDACTED] P46 [REDACTED], I can't remember. I recall someone in the house mentioning the fight in the town but I can't recall now what or who said it. I left the party around 5 or 6 in the morning and walked down

the town to the taxi, with Allister Hanvey and Christopher Henderson.


I saw police in the town but I don't recall speaking to any of them.
