On Saturday night 26th April 1997 at about 9 pm I got the bus over to the Coach Disco in Banbridge along with my mate Paul Currie. We'd a fair amount to drink through that day and night. We got the bus back from the Coach to Portadown at about 1 15 am on Sunday morning getting into Portadown at about twenty to or a quarter to two. We got off the bus at Z Cabs and Paul and I walked up the town towards home. I recall seeing a Police landrover at the Alliance and Leicester, just at the corner of Woodhouse Street.
