I am known by the above name and live at an address known to police.  
At about 9 30 pm on Saturday 26 April 1997 I left my home to meet Heidi Reaney and Michelle Jamieson. I had arranged to meet them at Connaught Park. I went there and met Heidi, Michelle and Wayne Lunt there. I should say that my friend Lisa Hobson was at my house and she left with me. When we all met up we decided to go to Michelle's house, I had a carry out and some of the others had too. We went to Michelle's house where we sat in the living room first of all before going upstairs to drink our carry outs. I am not sure what time we got to Michelle's house. I cannot be sure of times but a while after getting to Michelle's house we went for a walk to the [REDACTED] just to see who was around and then back to Michelle's house where we all sat around in the living room. I had been told by my mother to be home for 1 am on the Sunday morning so I left Michelle's in time to get me home. I am not sure what time I left but Lisa Hobson and I left together, we were going the same way as she was going into town to meet the Coach bus. We walked along Jervis Street and Lisa left me at the end of Jervis St when I went over the bridge and on home. I know I was home on time but do not know exactly what time I got home.

It would have taken me 15 or 20 minutes to get home. At the time I left Michelle's house, Michelle, Heidi and Wayne were still there. I do not know where they were planning on going but I think Heidi had to see Glen Mercer. The first time we were in the house I remember that Wayne ordered another bottle of wine by ringing a taxi, I am not sure which taxi firm he rang. While we were in Connaught Park that night I recall seeing Lee Stockdale. Whilst we were in Brownstown I recall seeing [REDACTED].
