On Saturday 26th April 1997 I was staying at my friend Simon McNally's house. Two other friends P51 and P44 were there as well. On Sunday 27th April 1997 about 1 20 am we left Simon's house to go to the Chinese takeaway at the top of Jervis Street to get something to eat, we didn't get something at that time. P51 went over to talk to a boy and a girl at the red footbridge. There was some commotion in the centre of the town so P44, Simon and I walked down towards the Church. We walked down West Street then up the wee lane at the back of the Church and then turned left and walked down towards the centre of the town but stopped when we reached the front of the Church. We didn't go any further than that. I saw a crowd of people in the centre of the town. There was a Police landrover at the Alliance and Leicester and a crowd coming up towards it from the bottom of the town, there were people standing at the landrover talking to the Policemen. There was a boy he was fat and he was shouting, "Chucky Ar La". I don't really remember what happened next but I do recall seeing two people lying on the ground at about Eastwoods and the crowd punching and kicking at them. I also heard glass breaking but I didn't see anyone throwing any bottles. I saw



Police trying to push the crowd back. The atmosphere was very intense and I didn't want to be there. We'd started to walk out of the town when we met Simon's mother at about Knoxs Butchers in West Street, she took us home. P51 had met with us as we walked out of the town again and he walked with us too. I didn't recognise anybody in the town that was involved in the fight it was too far away.
