I am a Sgt in the RUC presently attached to J2 Mobile Support Unit, based at Portadown in the County of Armagh. On Tuesday 6th May 1997 I was briefed at 0700 am by D/Constable Keys at Portadown CID Office in relation to a house search to be conducted. At 0720 am I entered [REDACTED] by invitation by Stacey Bridgett, DOB [REDACTED] accompanied by Constable [REDACTED] (log keeper) and D/Constable Keys. I explained the Legislation for the search being Article 10 Warrant, authorised by JP in connection with an alleged assault at Portadown on 270497 to Stacey Bridgett and his mother [REDACTED]. After a damage check was conducted a search of Stacey Bridgett's bedroom was carried out by Constables P34 and Andrews at 0735 am. The following items were seized, 4 shirts, 2 pairs of jeans and one pair of black boots. At the conclusion of the search D/Constable Keys arrested Stacey Bridgett at 0745 am under Art 26 PACE and he was conveyed to Lurgan RUC. The search was then terminated with no damage caused or complaints made.
