SIGNATURE OF WITNESS

I am a Clothing Wholesaler and was in the same business in 1996/1997. At that time I designed and sold clothing under the brand name SKANX. One of the retailers I sold to was Paranoid in Portadown, N Ireland. I can say from checking a sales ledger report for 96/97 that I sold goods to the value of £3,484.11 to Paranoid in Portadown. I have searched for the invoices relating to these sales but have been unable to find them. They along with other records for that period may have been lost due to a move of premises from a factory which I owned to my present premises which are a lot smaller. I can say from checking a computer print-out from the SKANX Autumn/Winter 1996 catalogue that we produced a silver sports jacket with orange 2" brading down the full length of each sleeve. This jacket was matt silver colour with a zipped front. The right sleeve of each coat had a woven badge with SKANX on it. A similar badge appeared on the left breast of each coat. There is a possibility that SKANX in large lettering appeared on the back of the coat. I think the lettering was orange and black in colour and was luminous. From memory our company made 100 of these jackets which I personally had designed. The wholesale price of the jacket was £24 and I would expect the retailer to sell them for no less

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£60. This design of coat was only made in the one colour. I have handed to [REDACTED] a computer print-out of the SKANX Autumn/Winter 1996 catalogue which included the silver sports jacket I have referred to. I have also handed [REDACTED] a page from the sales ledger reports relating to my dealings with Paranoid in 1996/97. The catalogue was made available to retailers in August 96 and orders received following that. We would have delivered in October 96. I can say from examining the sales ledger reports that Paranoid made a purchase of £987 worth of goods 30th Sept 96 and also a purchase of £740.25 on 11th Dec 96. All these goods would have been bought from the same 96 SKANX catalogue. I have only ever produced this one silver jacket as in the 96 catalogue. This jacket was metallic coated nylon.
