were in fact wrong due to a
typographical error and that in
fact it should have read as
Fonz or Fonzie.

He stated that he was not answering
any questions on the advice of his
solicitor, and that he had
already answered questions
relating to the matter.

He was advised that no result
had been received to date
concerning Forensic examinations
relative to him and that a
report would be submitted in
due course to the Director of Public
Prosecutions and he would be
informed of the decision when
received by Police.
