2 Q. Thank you. I have no further questions, my Lord.

3 [REDACTED]: No re-examination.

4 [REDACTED]: Yes, thank you very much.

5 [WITNESS WITHDREW]

6 [REDACTED]: My Lord, there are a number of witnesses on the  
7 papers who I would tender, my Lord. Constable [REDACTED]  
8 [REDACTED] who carried out a video film of the scene. This  
9 was subsequent to the incident, my Lord.

10 MR ORR: Not required, my Lord.

11 [REDACTED]: And [REDACTED] who  
12 appears at page 97 of the papers, my Lord, who accompanied  
13 the last witness during the course of the interviews.

17 McDowell who gave evidence earlier this morning. This

22 should my friend require that witness.

24 witness I wouldn't require him, if your Lordship pleases.
