SPOKE WITH ANN BOWLES 19 YEARS WHO STATES THAT SHE, HER SISTER ALISON AND A GIRL [REDACTED] OF [REDACTED], PURCHASED SOME FOOD FROM BOSS HOGGS AND SAT ON THE STEP OF THE ULSTER BANK TO EAT THEIR FOOD AND TO WAIT FOR THE ARRIVAL OF THE PORTADOWN BUS FROM BANBRIDGE. AFTER THE BUS HAD ARRIVED, THE THREE GIRLS WALKED UP THE HIGH STREET TOWARDS THE DIRECTION OF ST MARKS CHURCH ON THE RIGHT HAND SIDE OF THE HIGH STREET. THEY WALKED PAST THE POLICE LANDROVER AND WHEN THEY REACHED THE ABBEY NATIONAL BUILDING SOCIETY, ANN BOWLES SAW DEAN FORBES STANDING ON A CONTROL TRAFFIC RESERVATION. ANN BOWLES ASKED FORBES, "WHATS GOING ON", FORBES REPLIED, "THERE'S A FIGHT GOING ON". THE THREE GIRLS THEN LEFT THE SCENE AND WALKED HOME. ANN BOWLES DECLINED TO MAKE A STATEMENT.
