I am employed as a leading ambulanceman by the Northern Ireland Ambulance Service. On Sunday 27th April 1997, I was on duty accompanied by Glenn Stewart. At around 1 52 am, on this date, we received a report to attend an incident in Portadown town centre. We made our way to the scene arriving at 1 58 am. At Market Street/Thomas Street, I saw a hostile crowd of people and two injured persons lying on the road. We quickly checked each of the two injured persons and found one of them was unconscious and had an abrasion on the left hand side of his head. The other person had a minor head injury. I went to the ambulance to get a stretcher and Glenn remained with the more seriously injured person. When I returned the other injured person had got up from the road. I now know this seriously injured person was a Robert Hamill, and the other person was called D. A third person C Hull, who had a minor injury was also placed in the ambulance with the other two. En route to Craigavon Area Hospital, at 2 02 am, Robert Hamill was put on oxygen and all 3 were conveyed to the hospital, arriving at 2 09 am. Later at around 5 30 am on this date I transferred Robert Hamill from Intensive Care, Craigavon Hospital to Intensive Care, RVH. I had no further dealings
